Article VII Section 18 FALSE BURGLAR ALARM

When the Chief of Police determines that the Police Department has responded to a false alarm, he shall impose a charge on the responsible alarm users according to the following schedule:

- A. For the Fourth, and subsequent such alarms, \$25.00 per false alarm within the 12 Month (12) period, payable to the Town of Petersham, Town Treasurer. The twelve month (12) period shall begin with the first false alarm and extend for 11 months thereafter.
- B. This charge shall be payable within twenty-one (21) days from the date of notice. Failure to pay shall resort in the institution of civil proceedings for failure to obey the terms of this By-Law.
- C. All appeals will be made to the Chief of Police. After which, a hearing will be requested. This request must be made in writing to the Board of Selectmen within fourteen (14) days after the date of notice.
- D. The entire Alarm By-law is on display in the Selectmen's office between the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Article VII Section 19 FALSE FIRE ALARM

When the Fire Chief determines that the Police Department has responded to a false alarm, he shall impose a charge on the responsible alarm users according to the following schedule:

- A. For the Fourth, and subsequent such alarms, \$100.00 per false alarm within the 12 Month (12) period, payable to the Town of Petersham, Town Treasurer. The twelve month (12) period shall begin with the first false alarm and extend for 11 months thereafter.
- B. This charge shall be payable within twenty-one (21) days from the date of notice. Failure to pay shall resort in the institution of civil proceedings for failure to obey the terms of this By-Law.
- C. All appeals will be made to the Fire Chief. After which, a hearing will be requested. This request must be made in writing to the Board of Selectmen within fourteen (14) days after the date of notice.
